Mountain Resort Railway: The Akita Nairiku Line

The Akita Nairiku Line runs for 94.2 km through the inland area of Akita Prefecture from Kakunodate Station, a stop on the Akita Shinkansen Line, to Takanosu Station. The area along the railway line is home to countless natural blessings, including Mt. Moriyoshi, and the view from the train window is nothing less than Japan's original landscape. Passengers on this "mountain resort train" have ample opportunity to experience the timeless Japanese landscape.




Take a leisurely trip to enjoy the magnificent, breathtaking snowy landscape of Akita.

Akita Nairiku Line Snow Art

Snow art is made using footprints to draw geometric patterns on snow-covered rice paddies. The only place in the prefecture where visitors can view this art is in front of Jōmonogata Station. The area is illuminated at night, creating a fantastic atmosphere.


