

Cherry blossoms in Kakunodate

One of the most famous cherry blossom viewing spots in Akita. In addition to the weeping cherry trees lining the street of samurai residences, the 2-kilometer tunnel of Somei Yoshino cherry trees along the bank of the Hinokinai River is a must-see. In the evening, the cherry blossoms are illuminated, so you can enjoy spectacular night views quite different from daytime views.

Lake Moriyoshi-Shikimi

Lake Moriyoshi-Shikimi is the name of the reservoir of Moriyoshizan Dam, a rock-fill dam that boasts the longest embankment in Tohoku (at 786 meters). The surrounding area is home to the Moriyoshizan Dam Information Center, which has a coffee shop and store directly selling local produce, as well as a lakeside park with blossoming wild cherries and a BBQ space. Enjoy a tour of the dam or a SUP (standup paddleboard) experience on the lake's waters.

Todo Falls






Lake Goshiki (Lake of Five Colors)

Hirosaki Museum of Contemporary Art

Here you can enjoy art exhibitions that make the most of the building's unique space. The premises are also home to a cafe and museum shop.

Once the luxurious villa of Kenichi Fujita, a businessman of the Taisho era. It has a garden that cleverly incorporates views of

Mt. Iwaki, as well as a garden featuring a central pond where you can enjoy irises, azaleas, and other flowers depending on the season.
